


Lot #967.1 - 1972 DE TOMASO PANTERA CUSTOM COUPE

It has been restored from ground-up and redesigned to be able to reach speeds in excess of 200mph. Everything has been handcrafted from sheet metal. The engine is a Ford 351C built to NASCAR specifications with an output of over 500rwhp. It is extremely fast and able to beat almost any exotic. It is very reliable and easy to maintain. The cooling system has been updated with an aluminum 6 row radiator. All the cooling tubes have been replaced with stainless steel tubes and high quality rubber hoses. The brake system has been replaced with floating rotors with Billet aluminum that is NASCAR-style. Has Wilwood aluminum

4 piston calipers. All the brake lines replaced with stainless steel lines. Has a new master cylinder and booster. The electrical system was redone and all the gauges are Pro-Comp and Accurate. Features a stereo with GPS, DVD, CD, MP3 and is iPod ready. Also has MSD ignition, Parker funnel hi-rise intake manifold, shaft mount roller rockers to withstand high RPMs, CHI 3V heads that flow at 340 CFM, H-beam rods with custom ARP pistons, steel crank, 4-bolt main block, custom ground camshaft, solid roller, Ferrea valves, and Manley custom springs with titanium retainers and locks to withstand 10,000RPM. The exhaust has been custom made to exit in the center. The shocks have been replaced with adjustable coilovers and Spicer halfshafts rated at 800+hp. The ZF transaxle has been rebuilt. The wheels are 2 piece custom 18x10 front and 18x13 rear. Also has a Quickfuel 950 carburetor mechanical secondary and Edelbrock electric fuel pump with a Billet fuel pressure regulator. It took over 5,000 hours to complete the vehicle during a 5-year period. It would take a lot of work and time for someone to duplicate this type of vehicle. The power and the sound of this vehicle is indescribable. You'll feel like you're in a racer that is streetable. The looks of this vehicle will get you the attention you deserve, as it is the only one of its kind.



Lot #968 - 1969 JAGUAR XKE ROADSTER

This XKE Roadster is a completely original, one owner car with 10,385 actual miles. The car has never been modified, molested, re-painted or restored and has been in storage the better part of a decade. It has not been registered for road use since 1995. The original Sable Brown paint shows well and with the desired patina you would hope for on a completely original car. Likewise, the interior with its original leather is still very solid and rather supple with no rips, no loose seams, and no notable marring. The car even still sits in its factory original tube radial Dunlop SP Sport tires with matching spare that has never seen use. Included with this Jaguar are the original owner identification plate, the original handbooks in their plastic folio, period service manual, the factory original tool roll, lead hammer and wrench for the original knock-off wire wheels, as well as numerous vintage Jaguar Club magazines. It rides and drives new like new.
